Dear Gaesdonck families

With a warm greeting from the Gaesdoncker Campus we would like to bid you **farewell to the autumn holidays**.

Of course there can be no parental letter this week without at the same time mentioning the now again significantly **increasing number of Covid-19 cases** in Germany and especially in North Rhine-Westphalia. Many experts had expected this increase in autumn and winter, but perhaps we are paying the price for the obviously premature assumption in some parts of society that it is already possible to do without the annoying corona protection measures.

We are still grateful and happy that our **Gaesdonck family has not had any serious cases** of Covid-19 disease either in the boarding school or in class. However, it would be naïve to believe that this virus will continue to bypass our campus completely. We have therefore prepared ourselves for a wide variety of scenarios, be it a renewed closure of the school (which we do not really expect to happen at the moment), the quarantine of individual classes or levels, or even the care of individual students who have to stay away from class due to illness in the familiary environment. Possible quarantine scenarios in the boarding houses are also prepared for the worst case scenario.

The following still applies: please only send your children to school or back to the boarding school after the autumn holidays if they are completely healthy, but in any case show no symptoms of typical colds. Once again, we urgently request that you meticulously observe the protective measures of the Corona Protection Rules in your children's everyday life during the holidays as well: Keep your distance from other people in public places, wear a mouth-and-nose cover rather than too little, and remind your children of the special hygiene rules in this pandemic.

In our boarding school, 850 pupils and about 100 employees meet in a very confined space. Please make sure that we can offer your children normal lessons even after the autumn holidays by acting responsibly. Thank you very much for your solidarity and cooperation!

Return from risk areas during the autumn holidays

In this context, we must also refer to the current entry regulations from abroad into Germany, especially in the case of a return from a risk area defined by the RKI. The current list can be found at www.rki.de/covid-19-risikogebiete (available in German only). Please consider carefully which holiday trips abroad during the autumn holidays are sensible for you and your family.

The Corona travel regulations of the state of North Rhine-Westphalia in the version valid from 7 October 2020 stipulate that any stay in a risk area of more than 24 hours must be reported to the health authorities. After re-entry into the Federal Republic of Germany, a domestic quarantine obligation of 14



days applies, unless a negative test result can be proven, which must not be older than 48 hours at reentry.

It goes without saying that school attendance is not possible during this quarantine period. Therefore, pursuant to § 48 (2) of the NRW School Act, the school must also be informed immediately about stays abroad in risk areas during the holidays.

The resulting loss of lessons does not constitute a breach of compulsory school attendance. However, any performances not achieved due to a lack of qualifications (class tests, exams) must be made up for in accordance with the general regulations. We therefore advise you not to travel to risk areas during the autumn holidays.

Detailed information from the NRW State Ministry of Education can be found in the [here] linked information sheet. Due to the rapidly increasing number of cases, the legal conditions may change further in the course of the autumn holidays. Please inform yourself regularly about the current developments regarding entry regulations from abroad.

Re-entry at boarding houses

With regard to returning to the boarding school from other parts of Germany, we **continue to adhere to the safety concept that has worked out very well since the summer holidays**: Re-entering the boarding houses on 25.10. is only possible if the student does not show any cold symptoms and the arrival form is completely filled out. On re-arrival, and ongoing at weekly intervals, a temperature screening is carried out for all boarding students.

With regard to school attendance, the same rules apply to boarding students as to external students. In the event of cold symptoms, participation in lessons is not possible. The infirmary makes the appropriate decisions.

Cross-border excursions to Siebengewald

The RKI has classified almost the whole of the Netherlands as a risk area. Until further notice, our pupils are therefore prohibited from going on excursions to our neighbouring Dutch municipality. This is a strange situation for us in the Euregio region. However, as other measures have been taken in the Netherlands to deal with the pandemic, such as not requiring to wear masks when shopping, we believe that this measure makes sense for us as a boarding school community.

Elections of the school parents council

In the meeting on 28.09.2020, the **School Parents Council** elected Dr. Elke Schax as the new Chairwoman and Michael Lindemann as the new Deputy Chairman. We would like to thank both of them for their willingness to take over responsibility for our school and look forward to working with them. Congratulations on the election!

Participation committees of the students

1) the Students Council has elected

The active promotion of student representation and its involvement in school development is an important component of the committee work at Gaesdonck. In the Gaesdonck classes and year groups the pupils elect their class and year group representatives. These then form the **Students Council** - in short: the SV. These elections were held in the first weeks of the school year. A total of 54 representatives were elected.

At its first meeting, the SV must then elect a students' representative and a deputy students' representative from among its members. Mathis Lamers from the Year 13 (Q2) was confirmed in his role as students' representative. Nele Giesen from Year 12 (Q1) now completes the team of student representatives.

In addition, a so-called "core SV" is elected at Gaesdonck, in which pupils from the Test, Middle and Upper Primary are represented. The two pupil representatives also belong to the core SV. The members of the core assembly are Luisa Kaiser (5a), Arthur Müller (5c), Valerie Browder (7c), Veronika Jürgens (10b), Björn van de Laar (Year 11), Mia Sadeghfam (Year 12) and Nele Giesen and Mathis Lamers as student representatives.

The SV der Gaesdonck, especially the core SV, represents the studnets in the co-determination committees (e.g. the School Conference) and can address concrete concerns.

Two SV teachers are elected to support the SV. For the school year 2020/21, Mr Eul and Ms Niemeyer will take over this function.

We will inform you about the protection concept for these two days after the autumn holidays.


Special school bus timetable extended until the Christmas holidays
