As every year, the 2024/2025 campus booklet is distributed to all students during the first days of school. You have been able to download it from our homepage since the last week of the holidays.

Once again this year, Gaesdonck is offering an exceptionally broad programme of qualifying and recreational activities compared to other boarding schools. As always, it is worth taking a look at the

#### Campus activity: Golf

A good example of a campus offer, which was available for the first time last year, is the golf course in cooperation with the neighbouring Bleijen Golf Club beek in the Netherlands. Once again this year, students from the Sexta to the Lower Secondary (grades 5 to 10) can learn **to play golf** 



under the professional guidance of a youth coach (PGA) **until course license**. Further information on costs and registration can be found in the Campus booklet on pages 46/47. The programme is open to students of all types of attendance.

## Campus activity: Computer writing course

The computer writing course also starts at the beginning of September. Based on the results of brain research and pedagogy, this computer writing course uses visualisation and association techniques, NLP findings, multi-sensory approaches and networked thinking. The course objective can only be achieved through regular practice. On the last day of the course, a 10-minute writing test is carried out as a final test. Participants will receive a certificate on completion of the course.

This offer is also aimed at all students - regardless of the type of attendance. Registrations are accepted by the school office, by telephone between 09.00 and 12.00 or by e-mail.

#### Module courses

This school year, we will once again be offering your children a modular course programme to support them in their main subjects. This programme is a genuine Gaesdonck in-house development: In small groups, some of which are made up of students from different year groups, subject teachers help students to work through typical subject-related problems, deepen existing knowledge, rediscover forgotten material or catch up on important learning content that has been missed.
