Dear Gaesdonck families,

a strange school year is coming to an end. And up until the last few days everything is a little different than usual. Before we say goodbye to you next week with a last parent's letter, here are some practical notes for the last days of the "season":

Year end reports

The lessons of the current school year end for all students according to their individual timetable. Accordingly, on the last day of school the year end reports are handed over:

Monday, 22.06.2020 Year 6 and Group 1 of Year 9 Tuesday, 23.06.2020 Year 7 and Group 2 of Year 9

Wednesday, 24.06.2020 Year 8, Group 1 of Year 10 and Group 2 of Year 11 (EF)

Thursday, 25.06.2020 Year 5, Group 2 of Year 10, Group 1 of Year 11 (EF) and Year 12 (Q1)

Return of books

Since the collection of schoolbooks would be extremely difficult in accordance with the current hygiene rules, the classes of the Year 5 up to Year 9 and Year 12 keep their books over the holidays. Only students who leave school hand in their books.

In Years 10 and 11, however, all books are handed in. The class teachers Mr. Kisters, Mr. van Briel, Mr. Kösters and the head of the Year 11, Mrs. Kleine-Grefe, coordinate the return together with Mrs. Zalewska from the library.

House organization for the school year 2020/2021

Probably against the national trend - and certainly against all the confusion of the past Corona weeks - we are happy that we will be able to welcome again an increasing number of students to our boarding houses in the next school year 2020/2021. As we did at the beginning of this school year, we take great pleasure in the challenge of adapting the house structures to this development. In the next school year, we will reopen our traditional House Montecassino for the boys from Year 8 to Year 10. As already done with the girls this school year, the day-time boarding boys in Year 7 will move from the Juvenat to the House Kapitol. This enables us to form smaller groups with more individual care in the Juvenat houses. At the same time, three "real" upper school houses are being built for our students of the Years 11 to 13: Aquila, Quadrum and Phoenix.



With now eleven boarding school houses we are very happy that we could win Mr. Dominique Huyben as a new teacher for our boarding school team starting next school year. After his studies of pedagogy, Mr. Huyben was responsible for the supervision of the upper classes at Aloisiuskolleg in Bonn. He knows the Gaesdonck well – as a former student and longtime leader of our scout troop. Welcome!
