Emergency care on Thursday and Friday

For reasons of planning security, it is imperative that you informally register a required care with us by 6.00 p.m. tomorrow by sending an e-mail to poststelle@gaesdonck.de. You will receive a confirmation from us in the course of tomorrow evening.

Please note that the buses do not run on these two days.

Arrival at boarding school

Regardless of the development of face-to-face teaching, we will again offer a sheltered home here on campus from Sunday evening to all boarding students who wish to do so. We are currently clarifying the exact modalities of arrival and possible day structures depending on the classes offered. You will receive further information on this in the next few days. As things stand at present, arrival will be possible on Sunday, 10.01.2020.
