Outlook Carnival Weekend

It is still largely unclear how school lessons will be organised from the middle of this month. Further scheduling in the month of February will depend on the announcements of the Ministry of Education on the Corona Protection Ordinance, which we expect next week on Friday.

For the upcoming carnival weekend, we are largely sticking to our original annual planning: The variable holidays scheduled for **Friday**, **12 February**, **Rose Monday**, **15 February and Shrove Tuesday**, **16 February 2021**, **will** remain as planned - **no lessons will take** place on these days. The originally planned pedagogical day on **Thursday**, **11 February 2021**, however, will be cancelled. On this day, **"normal" distance teaching will** take place **up to and including the 6th lesson.**



Classes will resume on Ash Wednesday, 17 February 2021, in accordance with the Ministry's regulations in force at that time. No one can say with certainty what form this will take - we are preparing ourselves as a school for all eventualities and will keep you informed.

For our boarding students, this means that the long home weekend begins on Thursday after the 6th hour. Everyone is free to travel home earlier, but of course participation in the distance teaching is obligatory in this case as well.

We anticipate that arrival **at the boarding houses** will take place **between 6.30 and 7.30 p.m. on** Shrove Tuesday, **16.02.2021.** The arrival - should it come to that - is in any case binding for all those year groups for which attendance classes begin again after carnival.

Next arrival possibility

Despite the short following week, it will still be possible for boarding students to arrive on **Sunday**, **05.02.2021 at 18.00 hrs.** The procedure described in the parents letter no. 25 of 07.01.2021 still applies. Please adhere to the above-mentioned time. No doctor will be on campus for the first test after 6 p.m.!

Should a need arise after this deadline, we will certainly find a solution. Please provide your children with work materials for emergency care and - if available - a device for participation in digital lessons. (A limited number of laptops are available).

Please note that the buses do not run during the times of suspended face-to-face classes.
