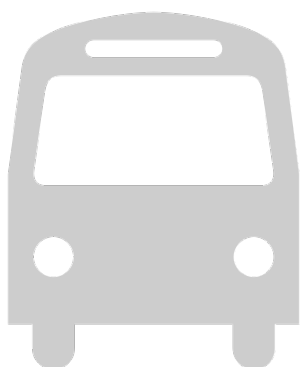
Dear Gaesdonckers



The set-up work for tomorrow's jubilee day is in full swing. As the weather forecast also sounds very promising, we are looking forward to a wonderful day together.

As a rule, we try to avoid a flood of letters to parents with two letters in one week, but we would like to give you some **important information about school bus transport** before the weekend:

Updated bus timetable from Monday, 09 September 2024



We monitor the utilisation of our bus routes very closely, especially at the start of the academic year. Of course, there are always shifts from year to year, so that the individual buses may well be full to varying degrees on a day-to-day basis.

In recent weeks, the route via Pfalzdorf in particular has caught our eye. Together with our bus company, we have updated our timetable at **from next Monday, 09.09.2024**. You will find the new timetable attached to this letter to parents and, as always, available to [download](#) from our website.

The most important changes:

- The Pfalzdorf/Kirche stop has been moved from line 12 to line 11.
- The Asperden/Bürgermeisteramt stop has been permanently relocated.

- This results in completely new departure times on route 11:

- The Goch/Hommersumer Weg stop has been moved from line 11 to line 12. The departure times remain unchanged.

Since 1 March 2024, anyone born in 2006 can identify themselves in the KulturPass app to unlock their KulturPass budget for their 18th birthday. This amounts to 100 euros. Young people can use the budget get for a variety of cultural offers in their region and throughout Germany. Books, cinema tickets and concert tickets proved to be particularly popular last year.
